



## ArtsNL HALL OF HONOUR AWARD

### Definition

The ArtsNL Hall of Honour Award recognizes a person, group, or organization that has made a distinguished lifetime contribution to the cultural life of Newfoundland and Labrador. The Award comes with a piece of original art.

### Residency Requirements

There is no residency requirement for the ArtsNL Hall of Honour Award, and the nominee does not have to be a native Newfoundlander or Labradorian.

### Nominations

Members of the arts community and general public can nominate one person, group, or organization.

**Nominees will be considered only for the category in which they are nominated. Permission from the nominee is mandatory.**

Nominations **must** be completed online at <http://artsnl.smartsimple.ca>.

**Deadline:** Nominations must be received by **Friday, March 12, 2021**.

***It is strongly recommended that the nominator seek letters of support for the nomination***, which can be forwarded to ArtsNL by email (alewis@nlac.ca) anytime before the nomination deadline by the nominee or letter author.

**ArtsNL will contact nominees to request support materials**, which will inform the Council's discussions. **Electronically submitted support material (e.g., PDF; JPG; links to video) must be uploaded by the nominee using the ArtsNL online system.** (A username and password will be supplied to the nominee in the event they don't already have one.) Nominees **must** supply a bio and a recent photo.

### Voting and Selection

Appointees to the ArtsNL Hall of Honour are selected by members of Council who vote by secret ballot. In the event of a tie vote, the Chair has a second vote. If there are no nominees, or if those nominated do not qualify under the specified criteria, no award will be presented that year.

**ArtsNL Hall of Honour appointments may be made posthumously.**
